Preparing for Preventive Clinical Trials

What's This Study About?

This NIH-funded study is looking at challenges in clinical trials for persons before diagnosis.

- 1. How early does the mHTT measure show up?
- 2.How reliable is the measure from two different labs/sites?
- 3.How well does the measure reflect disease symptoms?
- 4. How well does the measure predict meaningful outcomes?
- 5. How well does the measure track disease progression?
- 6.How many people are needed to test that treatment is working?

Answers to these questions will help test treatments to delay onset or slow progression such as gene therapies and new drugs.
