

# **WHAT** is palliative medicine?

Palliative medicine is a medical specialty focused on improving the quality of life for patients with serious, advanced illnesses such as congestive heart failure (CHF), chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), kidney failure, liver failure, dementia, Parkinson's, and cancer.

#### Consider palliative medicine when:

- Your quality of life has been

- Your condition has worsened despite the best care by your doctors
- · You need more help from family and friends
- Information provided by your doctor is confusing
- trips to the doctor's office or hospital to address your serious illness and its symptoms

# WHAT services are provided by **Palliative Medicine Consultants?**

Our Palliative Medicine Consultants will take time to get to know you and learn what is important to you and your family. We will assess your understanding of your illness and what your doctors have told you. We will ask about your spiritual and cultural beliefs, how you are coping with your illness, and how you are feeling physically. Additionally, we provide:

- · assistance understanding your illnesses and what to expect
- guidance with decisions on complex treatment options
- · close communication and support
- expert management of pain and other symptoms
- · promotion of dignity, comfort, and quality of life as defined by you
- a plan of care based on your goals and preferences
- assistance with advance care directives.
- communication with your doctor(s) regarding your consultation

You will then be contacted by a palliative medicine nurse to schedule an appointment. Most initial visits are one hour and follow-up visits are about 30 minutes.

The cost of palliative medicine is covered by Medicare, Medicaid, and most private insurance. As a non-profit organization, Palliative Medicine Consultants serves all medically-eligible patients and their families, regardless of ability to pay.
